Choose your cruise line & itinerary
Book your cruise (consider travel agent perks or group deals)
Reserve flights (arrive at least one day early if flying)
Renew passports (valid at least 6 months beyond return date)
Review vaccine & travel requirements for all ports
Purchase travel insurance (include medical + trip interruption)
Research excursions (compare ship vs. independent options)
Check visa requirements (especially for non-U.S. passporholders)
<b>◯</b> 1–2 Weeks Before Departure
Confirm all reservations & times
Print cruise documents and port address
Reconfirm airport or port transport
Call bank/credit card to alert of international use
Make copies of important documents (passport, insurance, etc.)
Download maps, entertainment, or e-books offline
Arrange mail hold or ask a neighbor to collect
Pack cruise essentials
Embarkment Day
Attach luggage tags before leaving home
Keep passport, cruise documents, meds, and valuables in carry-on
Arrive at port early
